- iFIT recalls NordicTrack Rowing Machines. The screen console can overheat and ignite, posing a fire hazard. [iFIT NordicTrack Rowing Machines](#)
- Scepter Fuel Containers recalled due to risk of serious injury, death, burn and child poisoning; imported by Canada Prep and Ship. The recalled containers violate mandatory safety standards for portable fuel containers because they lack flame mitigation devices required under the Portable Fuel Container Safety Act, posing a deadly risk of flash fire. Also, the Children's Gasoline Burn Prevention Act requires all closures on portable gasoline fuel containers to be child resistant.
